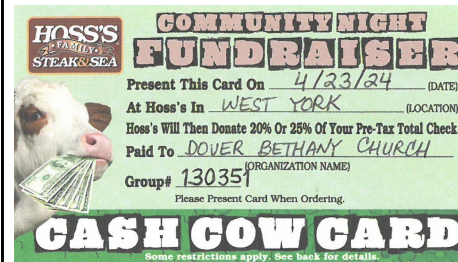
New Church Launch – Prayer Support
