#### **Church Plant Update - A Message from Pastor Emily**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We have good news. We have discovered that Asbury Theological Seminary is offering a grant to church plants to help with advertisement, property rental, purchasing sound equipment, etc. Dover Bethany's church plant qualifies for the grant, and we are in the process of applying for the grant.

We still need 9 people to have 100 people daily praying for the church plant. If you have not, please mark it on your Communication Card or call the church office to let us know that you are praying for the plant.

Our next major step is to form a core team of 4-5 people to lead the plant. Please pray that the right people are chosen, and that God anoints them with His Holy Spirit so they can lead in His strength and wisdom.
