### **Reasonable Sacrifices**

Many of you know my fondness of oxymorons, two words that don't go together: jumbo shrimp, white chocolate, bureaucratic efficiency. We just left a denomination that was an oxymoron.

I found another oxymoron: reasonable sacrifice. By definition, a sacrifice is the act of giving up something valued.

The word reasonable, when used concerning a price or a product, means not too expensive. It also means to make sense. It would not make sense to sacrifice your prize livestock instead of using them to grow your flock or herd. That would seem to be too expensive.

But to give something up that you don't care about is not a sacrifice. That's simply cleaning out your junk!

Why does the Old Testament take so much time discussing the condition of the animal sacrifices? Sacrificial animals were to be perfect: no blemishes, imperfections, no blind, lame or deformed animals. You were to give God your very best.

Therefore David says, "I will not offer sacrifices that cost me nothing." (2 Samuel 24:24) If it is a sacrifice, it should cost us. There should be some sting. We should have some skin in the game. There is no such thing as a convenient or painless sacrifice.

Personally: In your Christian walk with God, do you operate on the basis of comfort and convenience or does it cost you something?

Church: When it comes to mission, ministry, outreach, evangelism - do you participate on the basis of what you like and what makes you happy, or do you make sacrifices?

Something to wrestle with. Something to pray about.

### Financial Life of our Church

### Global Methodist Church Connectional Funding

The local church's investment in the ministries and missions of the Global Methodist Church are called its "connectional funding." The name reminds all local churches that they are part of one body working together to share the Gospel all around the world. The General Church (the whole world) and the Annual Conferences (our church is in the Northeast Annual Conference) have established a percentage each local church is to set aside for connectional funding (based on annual operating income).

Under this connectional funding model, the general church and its annual conferences must learn to operate with the funds local churches provide. Instead of being a top-down funding model, funding is determined from the bottom up. The finances available for funding connectional ministries is determined at the grass roots level. This way of providing resources for fulfilling the Global Methodist Church's mission and ministries creates mutual accountability between local churches, annual conferences, and the general church.

For the calendar year 2024, our church has been assessed: \$ 2,979 to remit for the General Church and \$ 8,937 for our Annual Conference.
