Since Last Year...

We host the York County Home School Choir on Wednesdays -95 kids!



- t Chocolate bunnies and contact cards distributed at Dottie's on the day before Easter.
- † Hosted and taught a Biblical Meal for 2 nights in May with about 30 folks.
- † Hosted a Car Show on June 28 with 52 entries.
- † Praise in the Park for the community at Brookside Park on June 7th, free food, church info and free music by our P&W team.
- **†** \$3,500 given in scholarships for higher education
- † Flood Relief Offering \$3,000+
- † 6-year-old Anyla offering to help with medical and other expenses \$5,100+
- † The church paid to send Pastor Emily to Malawi for their convening annual conference of the Global Methodist Church. Dover Bethany also acquired 3 laptops and software to send over and tee shirts for all their delegates plus some extra finances.
- † Aug 30 We held a craft show with about 44 vendors.
- † Sept: We had 4 nights of prayer (some as prayer walks in Dover and throughout the trailer park)
- † Aug 27-Sept 1: Dover Fireman's Carnival info table & give-a-ways
- † Sept 6 was a Hot Dog give-a-way at Dottie's
- † On Sept 13, we gave gift bags to our local businesses around Dottie's.
- **†** Sept 17 After the police shooting, we lead a prayer time at the old police barracks.
- † Sept 20 We distributed gift bags for each family in Llewyen's trailer park.
- † Oct 4 We gave gifts bags to the Northern Reginal police and staff.
- † Oct 5 We led a P&W and healing service at Turkey Valley GMC in Millerstown PA with about 70 in attendance.
- **†** We have a mission team of about 13 going to Nigeria in Oct of 2026 Fund raising rummage sale brought in \$2,000+ toward that trip.
- † Oct 19th Manchester/Mt Wolf Halloween Parade giving away candy and contact cards and won1st place for our giant shoebox float!
- † Oct 22nd Trunk or Treat at Dottie's with five different cars/trucks to give away candy and connect with the community. We had a prayer table and were able to pray with several folks. Possible 1,000+ families were present.
- † Hosting line dancing on Wednesday nights we have seen about 24 different folks!!! 75% of those attending is not Dover Bethany family!!!
- † Nov 16 Shoebox Packing Party: 250-270 in attendance with 1,602 shoeboxes packed and sent!
- † Hosting in our Chapel the new Spanish congregation: Trono de Gracia Inglesia.
- † In the new year we will be launching a Trail Life Troop

This doesn't count the "usual" stuff we do: Stiches of Love, the Warming Tree, DNA groups, Mission Central, monthly Food Panty Sundays, Kids Connection and Sunday worship! I am sure there are some things that have been missed on this list of mission and ministry.

The Dover Bethany Family is marked by faithful stewardship and generous giving: Between scholarships, special offerings, sending Pastor Emily to Malawi and Shoeboxes – giving over and beyond your tithes and offerings was more than \$30,000!!!

And with billboards 2 or 3 times a year, we are being seen by tens of thousands of people each day for the 60 plus days they are displayed.

Mission, ministry, outreach service!!! We celebrate all of this and continue to pray for opportunities to connect with the community, have opportunities to share Jesus, to see transformation and discipleship take place. We are not building a Dover Bethany kingdom or a Global Methodist kingdom but God's Kingdom!!!

Update on our OCC shipping account

As a result of some generous contributions, we were able to pay \$10 each for 1,600 shipping labels from Samaritans Purse for the shoebox gifts and have \$341balance as of 11/27/25.

We did a bulk purchase of stuffed animals for the shoebox gift for \$1,334. This expense came out of our missions account in the general fund.

We received \$468 in donations in memory of Lou DeHoff as of November 27.

Thanks to all who very generously contributed to the family of Anyla Sweeney. \$5,280 was received.

The balance in our Checking Acct on 10/31/25 was \$64,000. \$19,973 is available for general fund purposes.


