



Encountering God Church Camp



Our conference is having a church camp, Encountering God, at Penn Grove Retreat Center in Hanover, PA. The camp is from **July 19-24 and is for grades 3-12.**

A Message from John, Representative of Operation Christmas Child (Samaritan’s Purse)



John from Samaritan’s Purse met with Pastor Sal and Pastor Emily last week and asked us to pass along his heartfelt appreciation to our church for faithfully supporting Operation Christmas Child year after year. He expressed deep gratitude for the way our congregation embraces this ministry—consistently packing thousands of shoeboxes and helping share the love of Christ with children around the world. Our ongoing commitment continues to play a meaningful role in reaching unreached communities and advancing the gospel globally.

Updates from the most recent OCC season

- 12,199,337 total shoeboxes collected worldwide (98% of the annual goal)
- 10,903,548 collected in the United States
- 1,295,789 collected by international affiliates
- 474 unreached people groups engaged
- 11.9 million shoebox gifts distributed in the 2024–2025 season
- 6 million children completed The Greatest Journey discipleship program this past 2024-2025 season
- 7 million children currently enrolling for the 2025–2026 season
- Future goals: 8 million participants (2026–2027) and 9.3 million (2027–2028)

A story of long-term impact: Burkina Faso

John also shared a powerful testimony from Burkina Faso. Fifteen years ago, the Turka people had only two known believers. OCC delivered 2,000 shoeboxes to eight villages, and through that outreach a church was formed with many new believers. After years without contact, OCC recently learned that the church is now thriving, pastors are in place, and the Bible has been completed in the Turka language. It’s a beautiful reminder that a simple shoebox can spark long-term gospel transformation.

Praise God! Let’s keep praying for the gospel to go out!
