Line Dance on February 21st from 5 - 9 PM

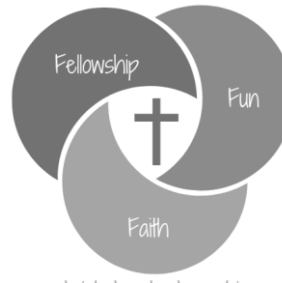

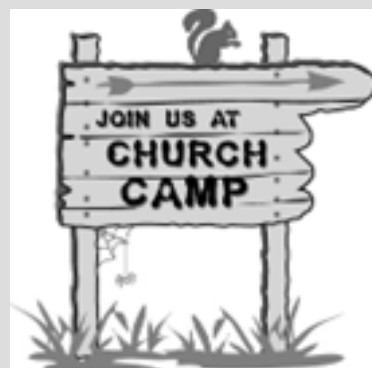
